Dear CSFA family,

To Gail – In Appreciation

Students of Jewish life and literature have universally asserted the centrality of the quality of "hesed" – i.e. kindness, empathy, compassion, and generosity as a fundamental ethical principle. For example – "Simon the Just" used to say – the world exists by three things – by Torah, by religious service, and by deeds of lovingkindness (hesed)' (Ethics of the Fathers, 1:2)

Or, at the heart of Jewish belief – והבוטה בה' חסד יסובבנו – "One who trusts in the Lord is surrounded by – הסד by kindness "(Psalm 32:10). I prefer a reversal of this text and suggest – One who lives with hesed is truly a Godly believer.

Or theology. "The Lord, the Lord – a God of compassion ..." (Exodus 34:6). The rabbis add the following: As God is compassionate, those created in His image must be compassionate. Or for the Biblical student – "at the heart of Torah is Hesed". Genesis begins with God clothing Adam and Eve, and Deuteronomy concludes with God burying Moses.

In light of the above, we as a congregation extend our gratitude to our own Gail Berman, who epitomizes the quality of hesed. For years Gail has chaired our Hesed Committee. I can personally attest to the warm feeling when at a difficult period this past year, Gail and committee members delivered a holiday package to our home. Family members and I felt a congregational embrace. Others experience this feeling as well. Our shul's concern for the wider community – clothes collected for the homeless, food served for the hungry, are just a few examples of hesed at work. And so, a collective kudos to Gail for her years of leadership. Hesed is an essential of Jewish life, of congregational life, of human life. It is the heart and soul of Gail's life.




